ABSTRACT

The main problem in this research is the phenomenon of adultery committed by a minority of politicians, especially members of the legislature that the Parliament had already terekpose in print, and has an impact on the perpetrator's political career, this study reviewed and analyzed to determine how politicians view the Parliament itself in meaning, and look at the phenomenon of infidelity committed bypoliticians in Parliament.

This study uses qualitative methods and critical paradigm pospositivis interpretive approach and using symbolic interaction theory, and this study found that most of the informants make sense of phenomena that occur infidelity political dipanggung essentially the same as other phenomena that occur in other stage and verbal communication symbols and non-verbal and so on are always usedby the informants in the interaction.

What has been revealed through this research means that the symbolic interaction theory dikemukankan by Mead also categorizes that humans are creatures that have not been so because of human interaction will always grow along the interaction took place, similar to what happened in the informant's view of the phenomenon of infidelity on the political stage or at any other stage, and all the attributes that complement the phenomenon of infidelity, which has become part of the phenomena present in it and so many symbols - the symbol of non-verbal communication and verbal.

Infidelity phenomenon has also presented the other side of the impact on the image for the politicians of his political career, because the politicians who have already become part of a "highly respected" so that this case reflects the lack of morality of legislative or political elite, The phenomenon begins with the adultery committed by politicians who had already given the trust in carrying out the mandate of the people so that researchers suggest, presumably the politicians which deserve to be role model for those who have given trust.
